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Finding Favor With God

The best definition of the word favor is “demonstrated delight.” The favor of God can be described as “tangible evidence that a person has the approval of the Lord.” When we favor someone, we want to be with him or her. We delight in him. We connect with her in a way we don’t connect with everyone else. We usually favor people who also favor us. In the same way, God shows favor to the ones who delight in, connect with, and give honor to Him. Isaiah 66:2 says, “These are the ones I look on with favor: those who are humble and contrite in spirit, and who tremble at my word.” Second Chronicles 16:9 says, “For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to show himself strong on behalf

of them whose heart is perfect toward him.” To be “perfect” toward Him means we seek His favor more than we seek the favor of anyone else, even ourselves.

Favor is closely related to grace in the Bible. Those who have received Jesus as their Savior are saved by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8–9). They know the favor of God. Without faith, it is impossible to please God (Hebrews 11:6), but those who have saving faith in God’s Son are declared righteous (Romans 4:5; Philippians 3:9) and live in God’s favor. The most basic answer to “how can I get God’s favor” is “believe in the Lord Jesus.”

God seeks out those who love Him and His commands so that He can bless, guide, and protect them (Psalm 37:23; Proverbs 3:5–6). This does not mean that everyone who is prosperous or healthy has found favor with God (Jeremiah 12:1; Psalm 37:7; 73:16). Nor does it mean that those whom the Lord favors will never suffer difficulties. Many people in the Bible had the Lord’s favor but also suffered hardship (2 Corinthians 6:4; Acts 14:22; 20:23; 1 Peter 2:19). Heroes such as Noah (Genesis 6:8), Moses (Exodus 32:11; 33:13), Daniel (Daniel 10:19), and Mary (Luke 1:28) were favored of the Lord, but they also struggled with difficulties like anyone else.

Those who are favored of God know that God is with them and that nothing can separate them from His good purpose (Romans 8:28). They have His ear as they walk through dark valleys (Psalm 34:15) and know that their struggle to remain true to Him will not go unrewarded (Matthew 10:42; Revelation 2:10). In addition to outward evidences, God’s favor

can be felt in the spirit. When we have the favor of the Lord, we rest in quiet confidence that our sins are forgiven (Romans 4:7), we are within the plan of God (Psalm 86:11), and that He is there for us at all times (Isaiah 41:10; Matthew 28:20). We walk with God as with our closest friend. We begin to see and appreciate the little blessings that God provides for our enjoyment—blessings that we once took for granted.

The Lord invites us to seek His favor (Psalm 119:58, 135; 2 Kings 13:4; Jeremiah 26:19; Zephaniah 2:3). When we seek His favor, we humble our hearts before Him (2 Kings 22:19); seek Him for Himself, not just for the blessings He gives (Jeremiah 29:13); and arrange our lives around loving Him with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength (Mark 12:30; Luke 10:27). We seek first His kingdom and righteousness (Matthew 6:33).

One way to obtain favor from the Lord is to seek wisdom. Proverbs 8:35 says, “For those who find me [wisdom] find life and receive favor from the LORD.” Psalm 5:12 says, “Surely, LORD, you bless the righteous; you surround them with your favor as with a shield.” Finding favor with the Lord keeps our lives and thoughts pure, because we desire to please Him more than we desire to please ourselves. Hebrews 11:25 says of Moses, “He chose to be mistreated along with the people of God rather than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin.” When the same can be said of us, we know we have found favor with God. His delight in us will be demonstrated.

The Prodigal Sons

And he would gladly have filled his stomach with the pods that the swine ate, and no one gave him anything. (Luke 15:16)

Man was created to be a social being and hence none of us can succeed by walking alone. Indeed the Bible says that two are better than one, and a cord of three strands cannot be easily broken. The greatest need of a man which is often ignored and abused is the need of his fellow man, in general man is a relational being.

One of the greatest days of your life was when you were born. Right then, you needed a push and a pull and the nurses gladly ushered you into this world with a smile. Well! You might not have felt the joy and cheer you brought into this world when you came or even heard the songs that were sang, but there was great jubilation. You competed with a million others of your kind and you emerged the winner. Many wise men saw your star and celebrated your arrival (You are a star).

Another star had been born in their galaxy. Hence you don't belong to yourself. You belong to a larger community than yourself and if you want your star to continue sparkling and shining brighter, then you have to recognize and esteem other stars around you whether great or small and learn to relate well with them because you can't exist alone.

These relationships should be so natural and practical that none of us should ever attempt to walk alone, because naturally we all need someone to scratch our back. Christianity is all about relationships, beginning with an intimate and personal relationship with our Lord and savior Jesus Christ, and then flowing naturally to the church, which is His body.

Resources and Relationships

The prodigal son was not poor because he had no one to help him. He had simply forgotten and cut himself from the power of his father's supply. Provision is in relationships. Relationships solve poverty problems. That's why the gospel is first to the poor because poverty is not a financial issue. Poverty is a relationship problem!

The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to preach good news to the poor (Luke 4:18)

Even the elder brother of the prodigal son was poor. He was living in plenty but he was still poor. His relationship with his father was very pitiable. That's why we still have so many poor brethren in the church today, because unlike the younger brother, these ones have been lost inside the father's house.

Which is even shod-dier than the younger brother. At least the younger brother was far away. But this man was living in poverty amidst plenty. He was operating in greater stupidity than the prodigal son.

God weeps.

Have you ever heard that God weeps? Yes! God weeps when he sees his children begging for bread when they should be running the bakery. The preacher observed the same wickedness under the sun.

There is an evil I have seen under the sun, the sort of error where fools are put in many high positions, while the rich occupy the low ones. I have seen slaves on horseback, while princes go on foot like slaves (Ecclesiastes 10:5-7).





The elder brother lived in assumption that his father understood his needs. He had forgotten the central power of every vibrant relationship; communication. Thus there's no difference in their poverty levels- whether at home or away; both were poor brothers because they never understood the place of fellowship with their own father. The dad was a tycoon. They were mere servants!

Resources don't answer to geography or proximity. The elder brother was living poor in the midst of millions. Resources only answer to right relationships. Africa is the richest continent but has the poorest people. Africans do not relate well. They are always fighting each other. They value their gold and treasures above their brethren.

The elder brother had an attitude problem. The younger brother too had an attitude problem. One treated the father as though he was dead. The other treated him as though he was a taskmaster. Neither treated their father as a friend or a companion. Therefore they were cut off from the most vital aspect of their deepest needs. Everything they ever craved for was in the relationship with the father. Their indepen-

dence was in the father-not away from him. But they never recognized this due to a poor attitude. Since they had a relationship problem, they could not access the glory of the father.

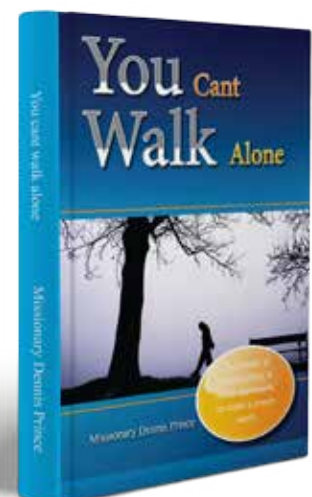
Provision is in relationships! Rewards are in relationships. Promotions are hidden in relationships. The elder brother never commu-

nicated with his dad. He treated him as a boss, not a father. For him, life was a working deal. He kept receiving a servant's reward as long as he worked like a servant. He was entitled to a great inheritance but his foolishness deprived him. When communication dies, relationships begin to die. And when relationships die, resources are hoarded and poverty begins to bite! Many poor people are poor communicators. All great millionaires are great communicators. The prodigal son came back rehearsing what he would tell the father. He understood communication. He understood attitude. By the time he met the father, everything about his walk, talk and facial expressions was communicating repentance and humility. The father simply couldn't resist this amazing boy! He didn't even wait for him to finish talking. He just embraced him in his arms with great love.

a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.

And Abraham rose up early in the morning, and saddled his ass, and took two of his young men with him, and Isaac his son, and clave the wood for the burnt offering, and rose up, and went unto the place of which God had told him.

Then on the third day Abraham lifted up his eyes, and saw the place afar off.

And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and worship, and come again to you. And Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and laid it upon Isaac his son; and he took the

fire in his hand, and a knife; and they went both of them together. And Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, my father: and he said, here am I, my son. And he said, behold the fire and the wood: but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?

And Abraham said, my son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they both went together.

And they came to the place which God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there, and laid the wood in order, and bound Isaac his son, and laid him on the altar upon the wood.

And Abraham stretched forth his hand, and took the knife to slay his son.

And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, here am I.

And he said, lay not thine hand upon the lad, neither do thou anything unto him: for now I know

that thou fearest God, seeing thou hast not withheld thy son, thine only son from me.

And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind him a ram caught in a thicket by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering in the stead of his son.

And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah Jireh: as it is said to this day, in the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

And the angel of the LORD called unto Abraham out of heaven the second time,

And said, by myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son:

That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies;

And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.”
(Genesis 22: 1-19)

God tested Abraham when he told him to offer Isaac as a sacrifice. Abraham was to offer his son at a place that God would show and not in any other place.

Abraham walked for three days until he came to Mount Moriah. In this place he was to fulfill God's plan. Upon this Mountain, he built an altar and he prepared to offer Isaac.

Moriah means all the mountains of Jerusalem. Among the mountains found in this area, Calvary, Zion and Olives are the major ones. Zion is the City of David. Mount Olives is the place that Jesus chose for his major prayers in order to conquer the world.

It is at Calvary where the greatest event of all times and

all places took place! This is the CRUCIFIXION of the only begotten son of God. Bible scholars believe that it is on Mount Calvary where Abraham came with intentions of offering his son as a sacrifice.

Calvary is the place where God tested all humanity. All those who believe in Christ have triumphed over this test just like Abraham did.

Abraham built the altar on this Mountain. Many Centuries later, David the King offered a sacrifice at this same place. God had commanded him to do so in order to avert his wrath from destroying Jerusalem.

This is the same place where King Solomon built the most significant Temple which brought glory and honor to God. Calvary was first sanctified by Abraham the prophet of God.

God's angel stopped Abraham from offering his son Isaac. He instead provided a lamb for the occasion. It is upon this mountain where Abraham called the name of the Lord as "Jehovah Jireh," for he is a provider.

After this act of faith and obedience, God again announced his promises to Abraham. Together with his descendants, they would be blessed and triumph over all their enemies. Through Abraham and his descendants, the entire world would be blessed."

She was your normal wife and mother, but she had great faith in God, and His promises. She was also a prophetess, and a voice of God, and she did not act of her own accord, but according to the instructions of the Lord.

God also bestowed upon her, great authority for her position, and she could summon Barak, the commander of the Israel army to summon the troops and go to war.

The Marriage Agenda

28 And God blessed them. And God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

After God did His part of creation and blessed the couple (Adam and Eve), where did the marriage institution go wrong and experienced all the evils that are happening? *Gen 2:20*



Divorce, separation single parenthood, abortion, abandoned children, and love triangles are some of the evils in our society to which our newspapers, radio and TV Stations, social media and the like have an extra eye on-Family/ marriage institution.

The married institution was authored by God at the Garden of Eden. He had in mind that this family will share in His Wisdom, dominion and blessings and man represented Him here on planet earth.

Gen 1:26 Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.

So the man gave names to all the livestock, the birds in the sky and all the wild animals.

But for Adam no suitable helper was found. A suitable helper" is mostly lacking in many marriages and when the suitable helper is present, the other party seems the opposite of God's plan and representation on the same. That person you can confide in-make mutual decisions as you look for ways to reach the ultimate goal of a successful, purpose filled family.

On the contrary, what we experience are;

1. People with a totally different perspective on what a family set up and family values are based on God's word.
2. Relationships based on wrong reasons and values that are the opposite of the divine purpose of God.
3. Incompatibility
4. Indecisiveness or Wrong decisions.
5. Imbalanced responsibilities.

These are a few among many others and result to failure in large numbers of marriages.

Having ministered in prisons for quite some time, I have had counseling sessions with a good number of inmates and understood some causes of crimes are related to problems in broken homes.

80 % of those inmates are either products of broken families, polygamous families or are themselves victims of illicit love affairs .Others feel the society around them was unkind and sought to revenge or fight back.

Rejection by biological parents or a spouse, sibling rivalry and lack of godly character from upbringing, result in crime.

Prov. 22: 6

Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Most Christians blame the devil on the many woes in their marriage - not putting into consideration that the devil found a loophole on the first day of the relationship.

When a relationship is based on selfish motives, greed, lust and the like; at no one time do you expect anything different to sprout up .The seed has already been sown and will grow with you!

The solution is to address it categorically in prayer, repent on behalf of the parties whether they are aware or still ignorant, and uproot it. .

In some rare instances the enemy crept in through a loophole and sowed the bad seed, it has to be uprooted and rendered unfruitful as we put a wall of protection around our lives, our spouses and children.

The church has to seriously go back to the basic idea and purpose of God concerning marriage.

May God help us realize His perfect will in our personal lives and our ultimate duty to represent His Kingdom; bearing fruits of godly generations who will seek to please Him in and through their marriages .Amen.

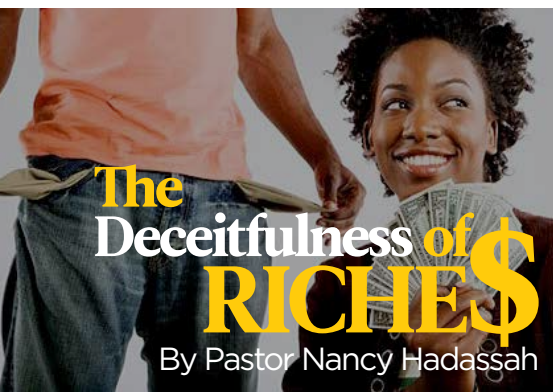
Many students got opportunities to stay as guests in the homes of South African hosts during the weekends for which we were truly grateful. We were all well received in the homes and taken care of very well.

As I listened to the Lord, He told me “my people have become so entangled by the ways of this world, that they think I am still with them but I left them a long time ago because they drifted away, enticed by the riches of this world”.

The Lord continued to say that the saints including some very gifted church leaders have followed after the ways of the world and are out deceiving the people of God, instead of pointing them to Jesus they are pointing them to the worship of Baal. *Revelation 18 (NLT paraphrased)* says that we must come out of Babylon, a type of the world which is a home of many demons and a hideout for every foul spirit, vulture, foul and dreadful animals and people have fallen into her deception of the riches she offers. The world offers a lot of distraction from the Lord and especially today where information and entertainment is so easily accessible on our mobile phones and other forms of technology. No wonder people are not getting answers from God, in church, because of the type of worship going on in some churches.

The desire in people especially the saints today is to own more and more buildings, land, latest gadgets, cars etc. This has choked the word of God, *Mark 4:19*, causing them to be unfruitful. Remember the word of God is meant to produce (*Galatians 5:22 - NLT*) the fruit of the Holy Spirit which, in-

cludes, love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. When we allow the cravings of this world (*1 John 2:16-17 KJV*) to have pre-eminence in our lives the fruit produced in our lives is sexual immorality (it's not a wonder that we hear servants of God becoming gay, sleeping with young boys, secretaries, personal assistants, pursuing the young beautiful worshippers etc.), idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambitions, dissensions, division, envy, drunkenness, wild parties and other sins like these. This is what pursuit of the world produces.

The Lord has shown me in *Romans 1:18-32* the reason why the church including church leaders are indulging in sensual pleasures, sexual immorality, idolatry (worship of Baal) etc, is because we have been deceived by the cravings for physical pleasures, a craving for everything we see and pride in our achievements and possessions. This are not from the Father, but is from this world *1 John 2:16-17 NLT*. This world is going to fade away, along with everything that people crave. But anyone who does what pleases God will live forever. Enoch walked faithfully with God, then He was no more because he was taken away by God. We will only experience the rapture if we are walking with God step by step, hand in hand. Let us walk in step with the Holy Spirit and we will not do what the sinful nature craves Galatians 5:16.

Some of us have been called to walk away from certain relationships but we can't because our flesh receives satisfaction from those relationships. Some of us have been called by God to His work but because we fear not having the income from our jobs and businesses, we fear stepping out. Some of us have been serving God in lack and take every opportunity while serving God to con people, to make money out of the church or from people forgetting that God is their solution and sole provider.

The church Jesus said, was a house of prayer but has become a

den of thieves *Matthew 12:21-22, Jeremiah 7:11, Isaiah 56:7*. Jesus takes these two verses from the Old Testament and applies them to His day. One verse was full of purity and promise: God's temple would be an inviting house of prayer. The other verse was full of conviction and warning: people had perverted God's right purposes for their own gain. In the courts of the temple, people were being taken financial advantage of, being cheated through exorbitant exchange rates and being compelled to buy “temple-approved” animals for sacrifice, on the pretext that their own animals were unworthy. Jesus denounced such greedy goings-on and physically put a stop to the corruption. In His righteous indignation, He quoted Isaiah and Jeremiah to show that He had Biblical warrant for His actions. What should have been a sanctuary for the righteous had become a refuge for the wicked, and the Son of God was not going to put up with it. God's design for the temple was that it be a house of prayer, a place to meet with God and worship Him. But when Jesus stepped into its courts, He found not prayer but avarice, extortion, and oppression.

Others are hindering their friends, spouses, children even relatives from going into the ministry and serving God, for their own selfish reasons *Matthew 19:29*

The Lord wants us to repent and to turn away from our wicked ways or He is coming to judge us *Romans 2:5-16*

Repenting means to feel or show that you are sorry for something wrong that you did, and that you want to do what is right.

Let us repent today saints and turn back to the Lord. When we do this we will leave with Him forever, we will have glory, honour, peace etc. *Romans 1:7, 10*

Importance of Wearing The Armour of God In Our Spiritual Life

God speaks to us in different ways as we read and study His word. In my walk with God revelation often comes as I meditate on his Word and in many instances it is overwhelmingly clear that it has to be shared with the body of Christ. Following is a revelation that came while I was teaching in a small school in my home area of Kinoo-Muthiga in Kiambu County where every Friday I would go and pray with the children of 'Rhemat Christian School' a young school that the Lord had sent me to. In here I was laying a foundation for these young children with a focus on our next generation who would have the mantle to lead in morality for generations to come. The young school had kindergarten and primary school levels.

In the Bible College where I did my degree, I was taught that if you wanted to raise a godly child, you would have to do so at the toddler level. If you waited and the child went past five years of age then it would be start being difficult to do so. The memory of a toddler is very sharp and grasps plenty of what is instilled into it and is able to carry it onto maturity. Hence the importance of instilling godly content in the

formative years in order to bring up a godly generation. "

No wonder people who come to seek our help in the ministry prove that it is difficult to change them from the wrong foundations that were laid in them at an early age. We really need a higher grace to understand this.

And so, what's my topic this time?

Importance of wearing the amour of God

In this, I want to prepare you for prayer. Before you set yourself for any prayer that would manifest what you are looking for, you need to wear 'the Amour of God'. I have explained about this so well in my book, '*About Warfare*'. I have narrated clearly that THE MILLITANT CHURCH which we are, (an army of God) must always wear this amour in precaution, for one does not know when the enemy may attack, as per the word of God in Ephesians 6:10-18.

1. Belt of Truth 6:14a

This is total truthfulness. Where there is a case of deceit and lying in the life of a believer, his falsehood forfeits that very thing that holds the other pieces of his armor together.

2. The Breastplate of Righteousness v.14b

The breastplate is to protect the heart of a soldier. Unrighteous acts committed by any Christian can rob you off your vital protection and expose your heart to Satan

3. Feet fitted with the Gospel of Peace v.15

This implies that one should be firm-footed and stable in times of attack. Shoes also speak about our firm foundation which cannot be wavered.

4. The Shield of Faith v.16

Faith is the evidence of things hoped for and believed in. Take faith as a title deed which is equivalent to owning a piece of land with your name on it as inscribed on the title deed. Your faith must function. For things to happen in your life you must spend quality time with God. Use faith to extinguish the flaming arrows of the evil one. Silence the devil by proving to him that your God can't fail you. (From the song, 'I have a father who never fails me'). You must believe it in your heart for provision of daily necessities. God provides, and in health issues He is a healer; you only need to believe.

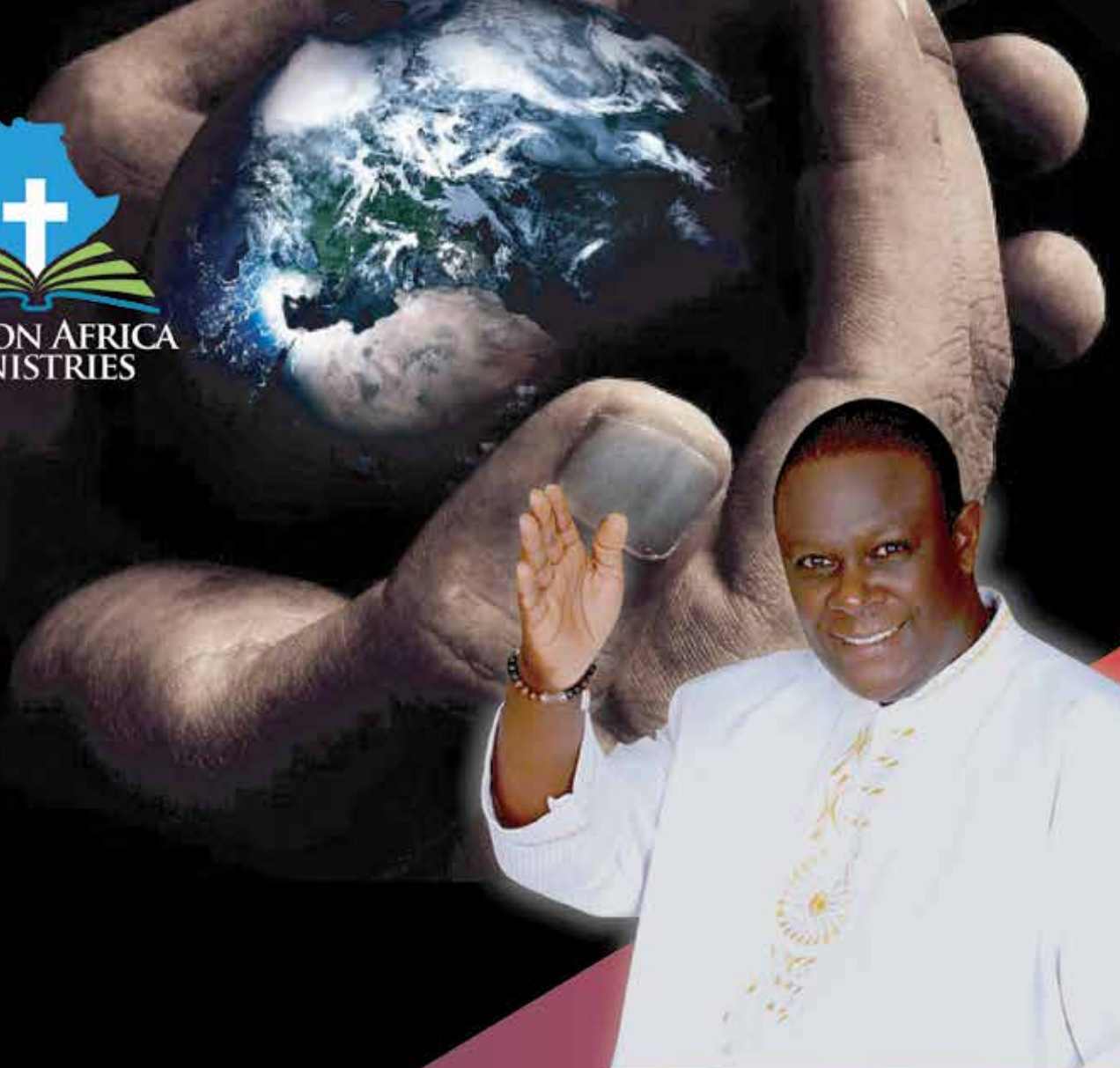
5. The Helmet of Salvation v.17a

This refers to protection of both the brain and the head. As I taught those children I would urge them to ensure that they wore the helmet to protect their brains from being damaged by things of the world e.g Rastafarians, anklets, nose-rings which calls for immorality in girls. The helmet is to ensure that our minds, intellect and spirit are kept sober.

6. Sword of the Spirit v.17b

This is the word of God. *See Heb 4:12* We must be advancing soldiers waging spiritual war till we get what we are aiming at.
